August 17 Sunday

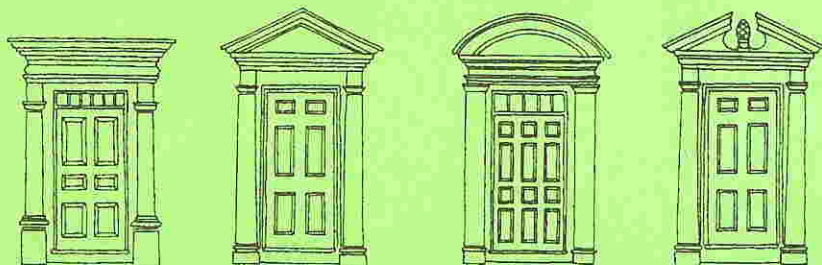
